Code of Conduct for Players

Players are the most important people in our sport. Playing for a team and for that team to win is the most fundamental part of the game, but not winning at all costs. Fair Play and respect for others in the game is very important and this Code of Conduct is designed to help clarify your responsibilities.

Obligations towards the game

A Player should:

- Make every effort to develop their own sporting abilities in terms of skill, technique, tactics and stamina.
- Give maximum effort and strive for the best possible performance during a game.
- Set a positive example for others including younger players and supporters.
- Avoid all forms of gamesmanship and time-wasting.
- Always have regard to the best interests of the game.
- Never use inappropriate language no matter what the situation.

Obligation towards own team

A Player should:

- Make every effort to attend training sessions and matches.
- Make every effort with Fair Play and the Laws of the Game to help her own team win.
- Resist any influence that might, or might seem to, bring into question her commitment to the team winning.

Respect for the Laws of the Game and competition rules

A Player should:

- Know and abide by the Laws, rules and spirit of the game.
- Accept success and failure, victory and defeat, equally.
- Resist any temptation to take banned substances or use banned techniques.

Respect towards opponents

A Player should:

- Treat opponents with due respect at all times, irrespective of the result of the game.
- Safeguard the physical fitness of opponents, avoid violence and rough play and help injured opponents.

Respect for the Match Officials

A Player should:

- Accept the decisions of the Match Official without protest.
- Avoid words or actions that may mislead a Match Official.
- Show due respect towards Match Officials.

Respect towards Coaches, Team Officials and Supporters

A Player should:

- Abide by the instructions of her Coach and Manager providing they do not contradict the spirit of this code.
- Show due respect towards the Team Officials of the opposition and to all supporters.
- Inform the coach or manager if they cannot make a training session or match.

Any breach of any provision(s) of this Code of Conduct by a Dynamo LFC player shall constitute a breach of the Club rules and shall be dealt with under the procedures as set out in the Club Constitution and Rules (Section 3.5).
